I will repeat this survey every week, so that if there are more updates from government or advances in science, you can change your mind, but obviously the more accurate the picture we have, the better we can plan for it ☐

### **About the survey**

You will receive a link for each of your children at school. Please complete one survey for each. Apologies for this, but to get the free survey option, we are limited to how many people we can send one survey to – the questions are exactly the same, it's just the survey name that is different. Obviously, your answers will be the same, but it helps us with planning and numbers if we know what to expect. Please complete this by the end of tomorrow.

Questions 1-3 are compulsory, 4 is only relevant if you have critical worker status (as defined by the government) and 5 and 6 are optional. The whole thing should take less than 2 minutes if you complete all the questions, and less than 1 minute if you just complete questions 1-3.

If your child is in **EYFS** (St John class), **Y1** (St Francis class) or **Y6** (Edith Cavell class), or if you are a **critical worker**, then it is really important that you either complete the survey, or just email me and let me know your thoughts re returning, as all our risk assessments and planning will revolve around how many children in those year groups we anticipate being in school (if asked to open) on June 1<sup>st</sup>.

I apologise in advance for the text reminders you will get regarding completion of this survey today, tomorrow and Wednesday, but I'm sure you appreciate that to keep everybody safe, it's essential that we have the most up-to-date information to hand.

I will feedback the results to you at the end of the week, just in case the outcomes surprise you and make you reconsider any of your answers. For example, you might be happy to send your child in, but if there are only 3 other parents expressing that opinion in the same class, you might want to change your mind. We will then repeat the same survey next Monday.
